** During **only** F/R Non-Calculator, you may go back to your F/R Calculator questions (but you can't use your calculator). So if you need to fix anything that does NOT require the use of a calculator, you **can** go back to F/R Calculator. So, save writing sentences until after the Calculator time is over.

Follow your QLN strategy for M/C:

- DO NOT do the questions in order. Questions that are easy for you could be at the end of the test.
- For Non-Calculator, approximately 8 Quicks, 10 minutes. You should be able to answer at least $\frac{1}{2}$ the questions, so at least **15** Quicks & Longs.
- For Calculator, approximately 3 Quicks, 6 minutes. You should be able to answer at least $\frac{1}{2}$ the questions, so at least **8** Quicks & Longs.
